1. This vacancy announcement is for the position of Division Electronic Warfare

a. Projected fill date: On or about 01 August 2014

b. Unit where vacancy exists: 29th Infantry Division, 9810 Flagler Road BLDG 268, Fort Belvoir, Virginia 22060

c. Female assignment eligibility: YES

d. Position MOS: FA 29A

e. Grade/Rank: O5/LTC

f. Eligibility Criteria:

(1) Open to Soldiers in the grade of O4/MAJ who are eligible for promotion and O5/LTC. Applicants must be current members of the Army National Guard Soldiers in Virginia or Maryland. If selected, Maryland selectee must be willing to interstate transfer (IST) to the Virginia Army National Guard.

(2) Current Military Technicians in Virginia are eligible to apply, however AGR's are not eligible.

(3) Must have a minimum of a Secret Security Clearance, or be eligible for an "Interim" Clearance as determined by the VaARNG State Security Manager (SSM).

(4) Must be a graduate of an Intermediate Learning Education (ILE) or Command and General Staff College (CGSC).

(5) Must be 29A qualified or become 29A qualified within 12 months of assignment.

a. Memorandum requesting consideration from officer applying with reason the officer wants to be the Division Engineer.

b. DA Photo Within two years; photo must reflect current rank, awards/ribbons; (if the award/ribbon is on your DA photo, it must be reflected on your ORB).

c. Current DA FORM 705 (APFT), within the past year with at least two tests, to include Height and Weight, go and no go.

d. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R, Body Fat worksheet within 30 days (if required).

e. Height/weight certificate (within 30 days).

f. MEDPROS printout indicating Periodic Health Assessment is current.

g. DA Forms 67-9 (OERs), for the past five years (Must be electronically profiled or certified true copy; UIC, CMD Code and PSB Code must be filled out for Part I; Gaps, overlaps, or non-rated periods must be explained in Memorandum format).

h. Officer Record Brief.

i. Most recent DA 1059 (indicating highest military education completed).

j. Letter of recommendation from the first COL within the chain of command.
