WHO MAY APPLY: **Open to all Traditional Officers in the Maryland Army National Guard in the rank of Major or Captain eligible for promotion immediately upon selection who meet the eligibility criteria.**

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: **Logistics Officer (J4) for Special Operations Detachment - Joint, Maryland Army National Guard. Responsible for theater – level joint special operations logistical planning coordination and execution in the SOCCOM AOR. Track logistical status and operational issues for all SOF; prepare/brief sustainment portion of the SITREP; develop sustainment estimates required during staff planning process; coordinate joint logistical operations and assist in resolving logistical issues beyond component/service capabilities; develop cross serving procedures for SOF when directed; validate and coordinate inter-theater and intra-theater transportation requirements and write logistical annexes to the SOD-J OPORDS and OPPLANS. Additional duties include SOD-J PBO, Budget Officer and Supply Officer. Plan and coordinate the logistical efforts in support of Military Support to Civil Authorities (MSCA) in state and federal emergencies.**

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must be an officer in the rank of MAJ or a Captain eligible for promotion and have completed military and civilian education commensurate with rank, policy, and regulation. Must be Airborne qualified or be able to complete the Airborne Course within twelve months of selection. Attendance at the Airborne Course requires passing the APFT at the 17-21 year old standard. Must be Logistics branch or be able to become qualified within 1 year of selection. Requires a Top Secret/ SCI clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable actions.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the fulltime federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs. This announcement is for (1) Logistics Officer vacancy - 005/01.

3. Current ORB/ERB
4. Personnel Qualifications Record (PQR) printed from UPS.
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. Optional applicant memorandum to provide additional information to the president of the selection board not contained in the above listed documents.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
