WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all Traditional Officers of the Maryland Army National Guard and those eligible for membership in the ranks of COL/O6 or LTC/O5 (P) who meet the eligibility criteria.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Serve as the Commander of the Special Operations Detachment-Joint (SOD-J); responsible for unit performance and accomplishments; primary focus is the training, manning, administration, and logistics to prepare the unit for federal mobilization and State directed missions; responsible to achieve command directed unit and personnel readiness indicators to include the USR, non val pay, retention, unit IDT attendance, security clearances, weapons qualification, DMOSQ, timely submission of OERs and NCOERs, FLIPLS, medical readiness and APFT pass rate; supervises full time staff, coordinates with higher headquarters, and prepares training guidance nested with MDARNG and SOCOM directives; accomplishes all tasks directed by the Land Component Commander, MDARNG

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must be branched SF and a graduate of CGSOC or ILE-CC and AOC which qualifies you as ILE Complete. Must hold a top secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must be in grade of COL/O6 or LTC/O5(P).

4. Personnel Qualifications Record (PQR) printed from UPS.
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. Optional applicant memorandum to provide additional information to the president of the selection board not contained in the above listed documents.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
