WHO MAY APPLY: **Open to current traditional (M-Day) officers of the MDARNG in the rank of CPT(P) or MAJ.**

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Executes the military response for domestic operations. Coordinates the military response through cooperation with the local civilian emergency management agencies and with the Joint Staff, Joint Task Force, and independent units of the Maryland National Guard. Coordinates with the Joint Planning Group (JPG) in writing and updating operational plans including CONPLANS, OPLANS, the Maryland National Guard All Hazards Operations Plan, OPORDs, WARNORDs, and FRAGOs. Validates plans through exercises using the Joint Training Model. Captures and incorporates revisions and improvements to operations based on after action reviews. Provides operational expertise to the JPG and to the Maryland Emergency Management Agency, including Emergency Support Function and CONPLAN working groups. Provides oversight over the County Liaison Team program. Conducts familiarization training for all staff on FEMA Incident Command Systems and JFHQ-MD mission tracking & Common Operational Picture tools.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must be a graduate of the Captain's Career Course with a preference for ILE-RC Common Core graduates. Must hold at least a SECRET clearance and meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9, and AR 40-501. Applicants must not be flagged. Must be a MAJ or CPT eligible for promotion by Time In Grade (TIG) within one year of selection for duty. Preference is for applicants to have completed ICS 100, 200, 700, and 800 prior to acceptance - completion of these courses is mandatory within one year of acceptance.

5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.

**All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.**
