WHO MAY APPLY: **Open to all traditional (M-DAY) Officers of the Maryland Army National Guard in the rank of CPT (P) or MAJ.**

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: The Unit Commander serves as the Commander of the Headquarters element of the State Medical Command. Provides appropriate guidance and direction for the administration, planning, development and execution of the Medical Detachment command programs. Responsible for ensuring personnel, logistic readiness and quality training are being conducted to standard. Develops policies on matters directly related to the Medical Command. Responsible for the planning, organizing, directing and controlling all aspects of the Detachment's performance during domestic support and other military missions. Accountability for plans, operations, administration, pay, safety and training of all assigned and attached personnel. Develops subordinate leaders for current and future leadership positions. Performs other duties as necessary or assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must meet the qualifications from one of the AOC associated with MFA 70 as reflected in Army Pamphlet 611-21, table 3-1 and be a graduate of the AMEDD Officer Basic Course. Must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college/university in a discipline acceptable to The Surgeon General. Successfully completed the AMEDD Officer Advanced Course and ILE recommended, but not required. Specific duties and restrictions are referenced in Army Pamphlet 611-21, table 3-1.

2. Three most current available OERs/NCOERs.
3. DA Form 2-1
4. Personnel Qualifications Record (PQR) printed from UPS.
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. Optional applicant memorandum to provide additional information to the president of the selection board not contained in the above listed documents.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
