SUBJECT: New State Chair for ESGR

1. I am pleased to announce the appointment of Jean M. Hulet as the state chair of the Maryland Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve. ESGR is a Department of Defense office, whose mission is to develop and promote employer support for Guard and Reserve service by advocating relevant initiatives, recognizing outstanding support, increasing awareness of applicable laws and resolving conflict between employers and service members.
