**AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** This is a squadron commander position and is open to commissioned officers assigned to the Maryland Air National Guard and those eligible to become a member of the Maryland Air National Guard.

**AUTH GRADE: Lt Col (Position open to O-5 and promotable O-4)**

### **POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

Commands and manages the intelligence squadron functions and activities. Establishes, revises, or reviews policies, procedures, mission objectives, and organization design for the staff, as necessary to eliminate work problems or barriers to mission accomplishment, promotes team building, implements quality improvements, or in response to concerns with regulatory compliance and/or customer requirements. Exercises responsibility for unit activities and operations, including any or all of the intelligence unit functional areas of training, standardization and evaluation, development of tactics, techniques, and procedures (TTP), simulation exercises, scheduling, plans, intelligence collection and production, analysis and reporting, mission management, and mission computer systems and personnel. Serves as the key advisor to the Wing Commander on all unit matters, including intelligence collection and dissemination processes, support requirements, and technical assets of associated intelligence-data gathering systems. Oversees the coordination of unit intelligence operations with other intelligence units and outside national intelligence agencies and major commands. Develops long-range training and intelligence plans for the unit to meet training goals and Wing level IG MICT inspection schedules. Coordinates required planning and resources with other units such as national intelligence agencies and NGB to support and implement the training plan. Directs the development of unit training goals and long range advanced planning, which include facility/equipment modernization, improvement, or replacement. Develops and oversees the development of detailed plans for accomplishment of these training goals and advanced plans.

### **MANDATORY:**

Applicants must qualify for, or already possess, a TOP SECRET/SENSITIVE COMPARTMENTED INFORMATION and have or pass a Counter Intelligence Polygraph. Applicants must be able to maintain this security clearance during their command time.
