DUTIES:	<p>This position is located in the 135th Intelligence Squadron. Supports all aspects of Air Force Cyber ISR operations by collating, analyzing, evaluating and disseminating intelligence information. Produces all-source intelligence, situation estimates, order-of-battle studies, and other intelligence reports. Advises commanders on force protection and intelligence information for US and allied forces. Conducts intelligence debriefings of US and allied military personnel involved in combat operations. Prepares and disseminates mission reports.</p> <p>(1) Produces intelligence materials. Prepares, maintains, and presents intelligence displays, reports and briefings. Compiles, evaluates, researches, interprets, analyzes, and disseminates intelligence information. Assembles maps, charts, and target materials. Establishes intelligence collection requirements. Uses automated and non-automated systems applications. Identifies and establishes unit requirements for intelligence reference materials. Maintains intelligence reference files, automated intelligence databases, and target materials data logs. Uses intelligence automated data systems to store, retrieve, display, and report intelligence information. Collates intelligence and operations materials, and assembles final products for mission briefings and training materials.</p> <p>(2) Serves as the unit's expert intelligence analyst for the commander and staff. Classifies research and performs analysis of intelligence information regarding hostile military, terrorist, or other threats. Coordinates requests for information with Air Force Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance Agency/ Air Force Information Operations Center (AFISRA/AFIOC). Collects, analyzes, evaluates and interprets intelligence data to project and recommend realistic threat scenarios, i.e., potential areas of vulnerabilities. Ensures intelligence products are adequately protected and have proper classification markings before, during, and after an assessment or other event.</p> <p>(3) Maintains and uses geospatial databases, target materials and other intelligence products. Extracts coordinates and positional relationships from digital database systems.</p> <p>(4) Utilizes intelligence techniques to develop projects and activities within a specifically defined functional area of responsibility. Prepares reports that include all aspects related to Information Operations/Information Warfare or threat analysis studies.</p> <p>(5) Responsible for the evaluation and interpretation of findings. Participates in committees and meetings as a representative of the squadron within assigned area of</p>

<p>QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:</p>	<p><u>General Experience:</u> This is a Maryland Air National Guard Drill Status Guardsman position open to current members of the Maryland Air National Guard. The authorized grade varies. Applicants not qualified in the AFSC must become qualified within 24 months. Must have superb organizational, analytical and communication skills. Must currently have TS/SCI clearance or be able to obtain a TS/SCI security clearance. Applicants must pass or already possess a current Counterintelligence Polygraph. Must be willing to be available for emergency response 24x7x365, except when pre coordination has occurred.</p> <p><u>Specialized Experience:</u> Knowledge is recommended of: intelligence organizations and systems; collection and reporting systems, procedures, and methods; intelligence information sources; techniques of identifying, collating, evaluating, and analyzing information; geographical and cultural aspects of foreign countries; current military capabilities and employment tactics of potential enemy offensive and defensive weapon systems; special operations; procedures for acquiring, updating, and maintaining intelligence documents, maps, and charts; map and chart use techniques graphic, oral, and written intelligence information presentation; capabilities and application of automated data handling and management systems; security classification marking and control; US sensor systems; basic electromagnetic theory; computerized systems supporting mission planning systems; digital terrain and feature databases; principles of precise positioning systems; targeting and weaponeering.</p>
