WHO MAY APPLY: Open to AMEDD traditional officers of the Maryland Army National Guard, and those eligible for membership, who meet the eligibility criteria. Officer must be a MAJ (O4) or a CPT (O3) who must be able to complete the Captain's Career Course within 2 years of command to be eligible.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Commands an Area Support Medical Company tasked with providing echelons one and two medical support to the 29th Combat Aviation Brigade. Directly responsible for all clinical and general operations management of assigned health services personnel. Plans, resources, manages, executes, and evaluates training plans and other programs to achieve and sustain a high degree of Soldier and equipment readiness.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must be a commissioned AMEDD officer and complete the Company Level Pre-Command Course with preference for graduates of ILE-RC. Must hold a secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. Must hold the rank of CPT (O3).

This position is not gender-restricted. Assignment of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the full time federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements (mandatory for applicants) within six months of the board date. Include the DA Form 5500-R/5501-R if the officer exceeds the authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
