WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all traditional warrant officers of the Maryland Army National Guard and those eligible for membership, and meet the required qualifications.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Supply Systems Technician is responsible to provide technical guidance to subordinate units, the headquarters logistics section, or other staff sections concerning logistics and maintenance management. Assists in the development of command logistics policies. Will assist the commander and/or hand receipt holders with required inventories. Will request, receive, issue, turn-in account for and safeguard all types of equipment and classes of supply. May be required to coordinate with local officials, service organizations, etc., for a variety of purposes: armory security coordination with police, rental of the armory and organizational participation in celebration. May plan, organize and assign work to employees engaged in logistical work assigned at the command level. Regularly interfaces with counterparts in the other TASMGs and Aviation and Mission Command (AMCOM) ISO Army Aviation readiness. Exercises leadership of assigned personnel in support of mission requirements. Assists the commander in coordination of support from war-trace elements in support of AMCOM IAW program mission guidance. Additional duties include providing the support to the Group safety officer and management of detachments while the unit is deployed ISO AMCOM missions. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Warrant Officer must 920B, be in the rank of CW2 or WO1 and have completed military and civilian education commensurate with rank, policy, and regulation. Must have a secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions.

### SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the full time federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

6. Height-Weight Statements (mandatory for applicants) within six months of the board date. Include the DA Form 5500-R/5501-R if the officer exceeds the authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
