WHO MAY APPLY: Open to all traditional commissioned officers of the Maryland Army National Guard, and those eligible for membership, who meet the eligibility criteria in the grade of LTC or MAJ promotable.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Serves as the principal advisor to the Group Commander providing recommendations concerning command decisions, policies and exercise full authority to direct necessary staff actions. Supervises the execution of command missions, priorities and policies. Responsible for the oversight of individual and collective unit readiness. Supervises the Group Rating, Warehouse, and Aviation Safety programs. Maintains oversight of operational plans and orders. Serves as the senior command representative forward during split based operation. Interfaces with the subordinate TASMG elements in other States, and Aviation and Missile Command (AMCOM) in support of CONUS and OCONUS readiness and missions.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must be a commissioned officer in the rank of LTC or MAJ promotable and have completed military and civilian education commensurate with rank, policy, and regulation. Must be qualified as an Aviation Officer (15B) and availability to attend AMOC within one year is preferred. Must have a secret clearance and be deployable. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the full time federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements (mandatory for applicants) within six months of the board date. Include the DA Form 5500-R/5501-R if the officer exceeds the authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
