

TRADITIONAL GUARD OFFICER VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

175th WING INTELLIGENCE OFFICER CLOSING DATE: 4 April 2016

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This is a commissioned officer position. This is open for Maryland Air National Guard enlisted members eligible for commissioning.

UNIT: 135th Intelligence Squadron AFSC: 14N AUTH GRADE: Major

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Position necessitates a member that is ready to lead in intelligence operations and will entail time and effort towards growing Airmen. This position requires completion of intelligence AFSC awarding training and accomplishment of applicable mission qualification training. When called upon, member will lead squadron shops such as Intelligence flights, Training, Standards/Evaluations, Plans and Systems. Member will also have additional duty responsibilities and supervisory duties. In these roles, this position requires the member to establish priorities, manage production, processing and dissemination of intelligence analysis and products. Specifically for analysis, member will oversee fusion of collected intelligence, will produce assessments to meet operational requirements and analyze data to advise planners of options that accomplish objectives. This position will also assist in determining unit requirements and tailoring intelligence support to missions, equipment, and employment tactics. Further roles may include establishing, recommending, and disseminating information for intelligence collection requirements. Above all, this position will require directing intelligence activities, to include operations, exercises, training, evaluations and project taskings. To accomplish these tasks, member will learn the ins and outs of organizations, policy and plan application, concept refinement, systems and orders within Intelligence, Cyber and Cryptologic communities.

PREREQUISITES:

Enlisted Personnel Prerequisites:

- Must be less than 40 years of age at time of commissioning with the following rules applying:
 - 1 year of enlisted time – must be no older than 36 at time of commissioning
 - 2 to 5 years of enlisted time - must be no older than 37 thru 40 respectively
 - Air Force Officer Qualification Test (Minimum 15 Verbal and 10 Quantitative).

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO AFSC 14N:

- Applicants must qualify for or already possess a TOP SECRET clearance.
- Applicants must qualify for or already possess a current Single Scope Background Investigation (SSBI) according to AFI 31-501, *Personnel Security Program Management* is mandatory.
- Applicants must pass or already possess a Counter-Intelligence (CI) Polygraph.

EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR AFSC 14N:

- A 4-year degree (any specialty) is required for commissioning in the MDANG.
