WHO MAY APPLY: This is a Maryland Army National Guard (MDARNG) position open Nationwide and to the United States Army Reserve to Traditional Officer and Technician Officers with the rank of LTC or MAJ (DA selected to LTC).

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Senior Intelligence Officer and principal staff officer for all matters concerning strategic planning, military intelligence, counterintelligence, security operations, and intelligence training. Serves as the Division Commander's subject matter expert on all intelligence matters. Supervises the collection, analysis, production, and dissemination of intelligence. Exercises command and control over the Division intelligence organization to conduct intelligence and electronic warfare operations to satisfy the requirements of the Commander and force protection. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must be an officer in the rank of LTC or MAJ (DA selected to LTC) and must be complete with Intermediate Learning Education (ILE) – Common Core or Command and General Staff College (CGSC). Requires ability to receive a Top Secret/SCI clearance.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry in the fulltime federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

1. Memorandum requesting consideration from officer applying with reason why the officer wants to be the Division MI Officer.
2. Current ORB/ERB
3. OERs for the past five years (Must be electronically profiled or certified true copy; gaps, overlaps, or non-rated periods must be explained in Memorandum format).
4. Most recent DA 1059 indicating highest military education completed
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the closing date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the closing date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. DA Photo within five years; photo must reflect current rank, awards/ribbons.
8. MEDPROS printout individual PQR indicating Periodic Health Assessment is current.
9. Letter of recommendation from chain of command. (Optional)

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
