WHO MAY APPLY: This is a Maryland Army National Guard position open to current Traditional Warrant Officers of the Army National Guard in all 54 states and territories. Warrant Officers from other States/Territories would be required to interstate transfer to the MDARNG. All Warrant Officers must meet grade and required qualifications listed below. Applications from those Officers not meeting these requirements will be returned without action.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Responsible for materiel readiness, preparation, and tracking for the Theater-Level Aviation Maintenance Group. Provides expertise, advice and guidance to the S-4 in all aspects of materiel management in support of CONUS and OCONUS operations and deployments. Regularly interfaces with counterparts in the other TASMs and Aviation and Missile Command (AMCOM) ISO Army Aviation readiness. Exercises leadership of assigned personnel in support of mission requirements. Assists the commander in coordination of support from war-trace elements in support of AMCOM IAW program mission guidance. Additional duties include providing the support to the Group safety officer and management of detachments while the unit is deployed ISO AMCOM missions. Advise Group commander on aviation readiness and operational issues related to unit personnel, training, and equipment readiness.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Position is a 153AL (AVN). Warrant Officer in the rank of CW5 or CW4 eligible for promotion upon selection. Must have completed military education commensurate with rank, policy, and regulation. Must have secret clearance. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 350-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions.

### SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the full time federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

4. Personnel Qualifications Record (PQR) printed from UPS.
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. Optional applicant memorandum to provide additional information to the president of the selection board not contained in the above listed documents.

**All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.**
