WHO MAY APPLY: Open to Aviation branch traditional (M-Day) officers of the Maryland Army National Guard and those eligible for membership, who meet the eligibility criteria. Officer must be in the grade of CPT or 1LT eligible for immediate promotion to CPT.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Commander of a UH-60 Assault Company and 3 Detachments in an Air Assault Battalion. Responsible for the training, discipline, safety, welfare, morale, accountability, deploy-ability and combat readiness of 10 UH-60s, 81 personnel, and all associated MTOE equipment valued at over 200 million dollars. Responsible for the integration of the company in the combined arms fight and the management of the Company's Aircrew Training Program. Ensures Soldiers and aircrews are properly trained at the individual, crew, and unit collective level. Maintains FAC 1, RL1 D/N/NVG PC qualification and requirements.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must be a rated Army Aviator of the Maryland Army National Guard. Must meet the physical requirements of AR 250-15, AR 600-9 and AR 40-501. Applicant must not be currently under suspension of favorable personnel actions. For promotion, 1LTs must be 15/AV series and have completed military and civilian education commensurate with rank, policy, and regulation.

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply. Application for this position DOES NOT constitute application for entry into the full time federal technician or Active Guard Reserve (AGR) programs.

5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements (mandatory for applicants) within six months of the board date. Include the DA Form 5500-R/5501-R if the officer exceeds the authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
