WHO MAY APPLY: **Open to traditional officers of the Maryland Army National Guard in the grades of O4 and O3 immediately promotable upon selection. Must possess AOC 13A Field Artillery.**

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: Fire Support Liaison Officer responsible for ensuring fire support coordination with host nation headquarters' fires and artillery personnel at a corps level and above coalition, joint, or multinational headquarters. Assists the Fires Chief in supervising the overall activities and training of the section. Ensures mutual understanding and unity of effort, synchronizing host fires with current Army combat operations, integrating lethal and nonlethal fires into current operations, and planning for future operations. Coordinates fire support coordination measures. Updates host nation fire support section on current friendly and enemy operations, target lists, and fire support priorities. Monitors the execution of ARFOR and host fires. Briefs host nation fire support section on current and future ARFOR lethal and nonlethal fires. Ensures digital information systems, ground operations maps, and orders of battle are current to support fire support coordination. In support of state missions, adapts liaison skills to provide coordination as a part of a multi-agency joint operations center.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Must be in the grade of MAJ (O4) or CPT (O3) immediately promotable upon selection. Must possess AOC 13A Field Artillery. Must possess a security clearance of Secret.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

Position is not gender restricted. Assignment limitations of NGR 600-100 apply.

2. Three most current available OERs/NCOERs.
3. Officer Record Brief (ORB)
4. Personnel Qualifications Record (PQR) printed from UPS.
5. DA Form 705 (APFT Scorecard) within 12 months of the board date. A physical profile may be submitted in lieu of APFT record.
6. Height-Weight Statements within 6 months of the board date. DA Form 5500-R/5501-R must be included if soldier exceeds authorized screening table weight of AR 600-9.
7. Optional applicant memorandum to provide additional information to the president of the selection board not contained in the above listed documents.

All applications will be screened without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender or national origin. Selection will be made the basis of military education, skills and individual experience.
